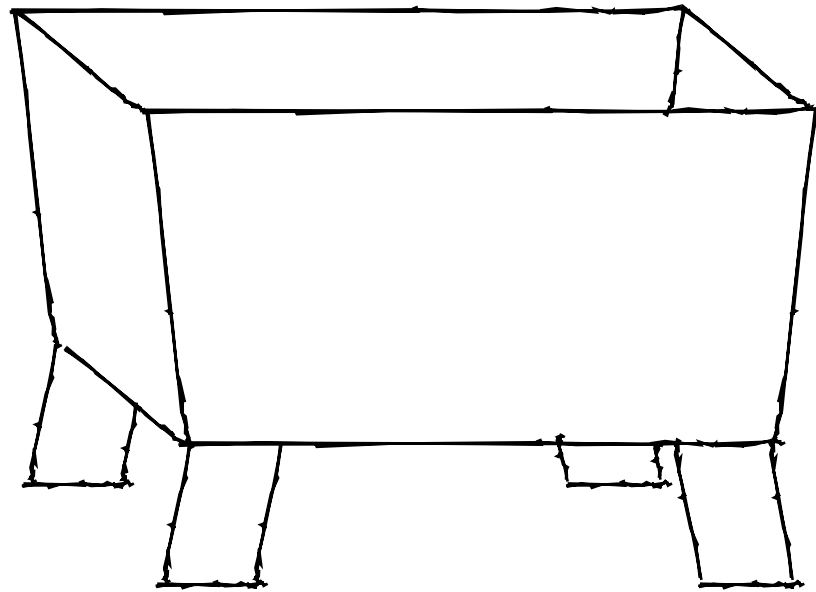




The Story of Jesus

Draw or write a prayer for someone who needs Jesus.

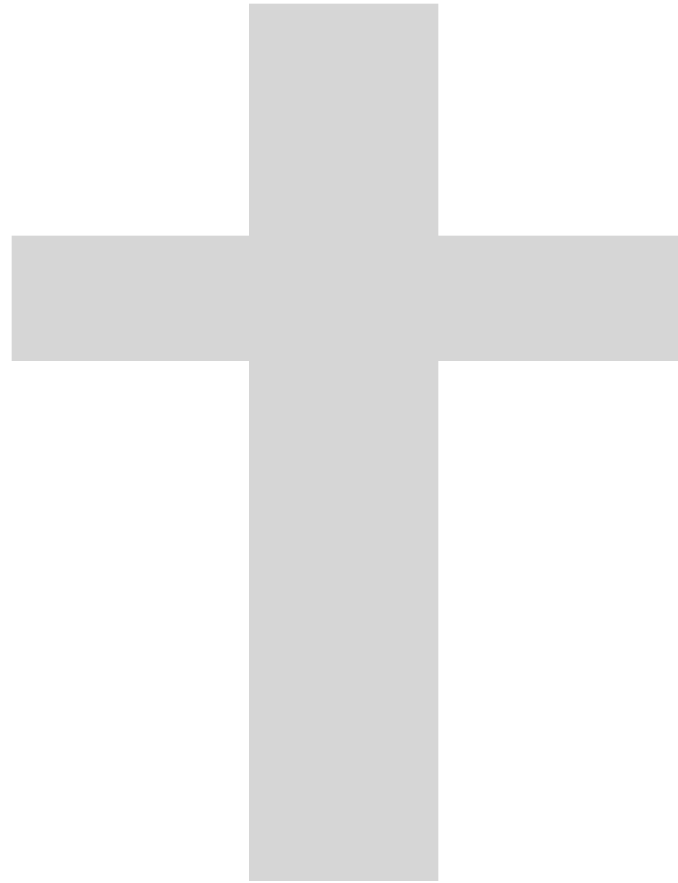
29 Jesus left there and went along the Sea of Galilee. Then he went up on a mountainside and sat down.

And they praised the God of Israel.

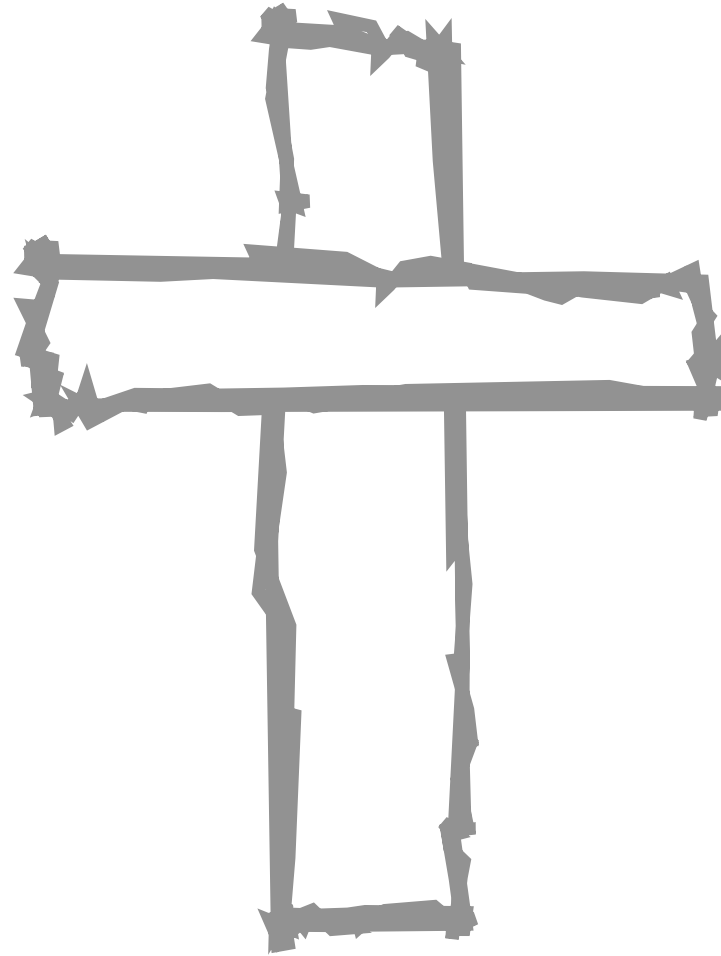
Open the red egg and wear what's inside.

16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16 (NIV)

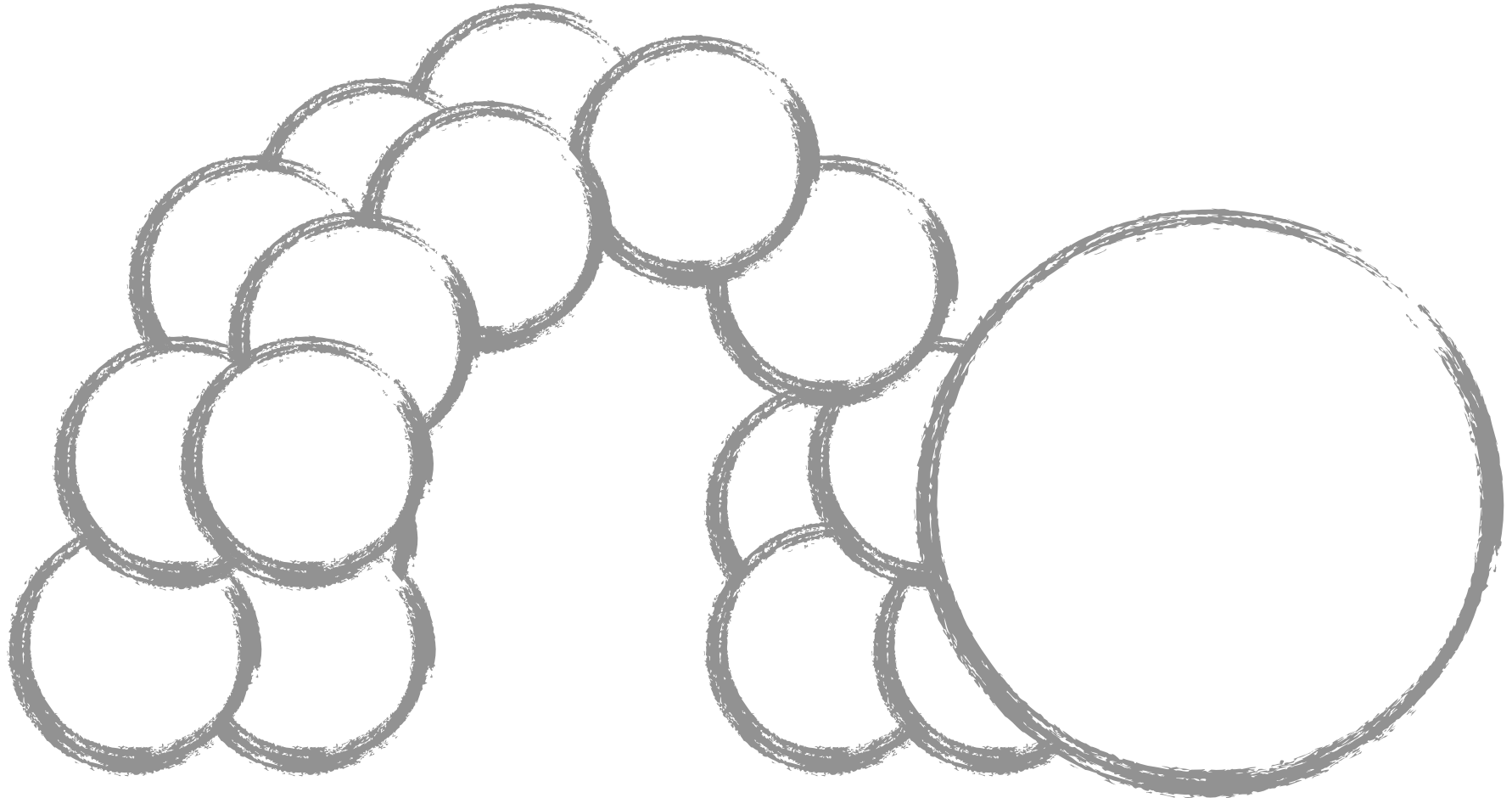
Open the white egg and use what's inside.

9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9 (NIV)

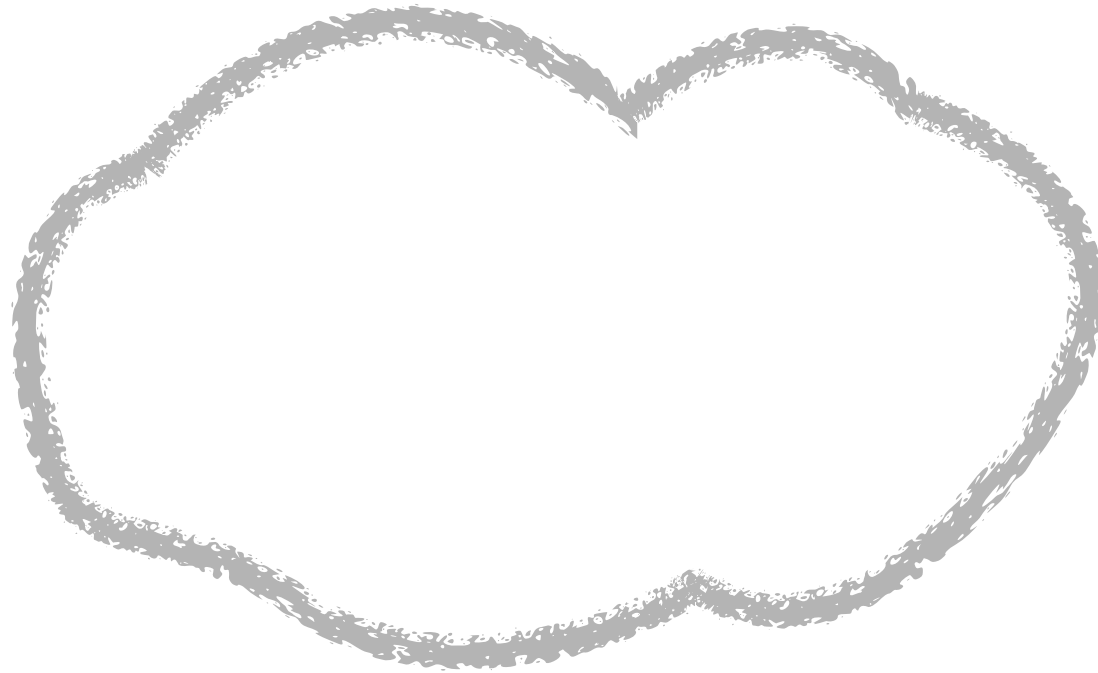
The pink egg is empty - there's nothing inside.
Jesus came back to life after he died.

Open up the orange egg & watch the bubbles rise.
Jesus wished his friends good bye
and rose up through the skies.



Draw Jesus going behind the clouds.
